Tune: 32 bar reel (Noonday Serenade, by Keith Malcolm)

MI and M3, on Rt diagonals, pull by Rt (2 bars), then do ½ LH ΑI Turn with the Man they are now opposite (2 bars); Then LI and L3, on Left diagonals, pull by Left (2 bars) then 1/2 RH turn with the person they are now opposite (2 bars). All are now next to Ptnr but improper. Ladies Line: MI LI M3 L3 Men's Line: L2 M2 L4 M4 **A2** All back-to-back the Opposite Rt Shldr (4 bars); Pass through across Rt shldr and loop Left to face (4 bars). Order now: Ladies Line: L2 M2 L4 M4 Men's Line: MI LI M3 L3 On the long Left diagonal [2^{nd} long corner places], $\frac{1}{2}$ R&L (4 bars); BI In 4s, ½ Ladies Chain across (4 bars). Order now: Is, 3s imp, 2s, 4s imp In 4s, lower couple ½ figure 8 up though upper couple (4 bars); **B2** In same 4s, cast and lead – upper couples wide cast down a place, lower couples meet, lead up a place and fall back, all finishing in set lines (4 bars).

Progression: 3, 1, 4, 2.

In AI, bars 3 and 4, all 4 Men are doing ½ LH turns.

MI and M3 keep turning Left out of those turns onto the Left diagonal to a Left pull by with their Ptnr.
