Cara King, 2023 Longways, duple minor Tune: "Farewell Jig" by Lael Whitehead (AABB) 6/8

At beginning of the dance, the left-file dancers (a.k.a. men) are facing up the hall, and the right-file dancers facing down.

A1	1-4	All forward a double and back.
	5-6	Partners right-hand turn 3/4 into wavy lines.
	7-8	All set.
A2	1-4	All forward a double and back.
	5-6	Partners right-hand turn 3/4, until nearly side-by-side (but slightly offset, so those facing down are a bit higher than their partners).
	7-8	All set.
B1	1-4	On the 2nd diagonal, four changes of a hey-for-four (start by passing partner right shoulder). <i>The original first-corner people don't loop back for their fourth change, but instead head clockwise around the circle one place.</i>
	5-8	All single-file circle clockwise until progressed and proper ( <i>about three places</i> ).
B2	1-4 5-8	Facing partner, all double mad robin clockwise. All set toward partner, then turn single 3/4 into single-file lines.
